


1.2.3. Easy Steps to Properly Use a MARKETING NAME in MLS

1. Register your Marketing Name with DSPS

Your Marketing Name used in MLS MUST match the registered name with DSPS. To check or register your name with DSPS, go to <https://app.wi.gov/licensesearch>

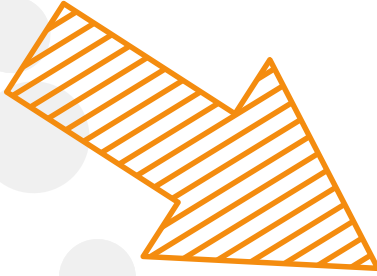
